A program officer at camps involves a range of positions working at an outdoor camp facility; within this camp, there are many different roles you may undertake, from being a program assistant, activity instructor, school camp facilitator, or outdoor education teacher. Within these roles, you typically get to experience a wide range of outdoor environments and activities. For example, you may assist in setting up the high ropes course in the morning and running a session on rock climbing in the afternoon.
